# TASK A: ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY GENERAL REMARKS

The expected text is an argumentative essay.

- Consider the following for the marks
- ❖ Understanding of the task: writing an argumentative essay.
- Understanding of the topic (viewpoint on George Bush's assertion about illegal immigration).

The candidate's production should have the following features:

Introduction

- Body / Development (in paragraphs at least 2)
- A conclusion
- ❖ Introduction (5 pts)
- Development in paragraphs (30 pts)
- Paragraph 1: Students should carry out a demonstrative writing showing the unavoidable impact that an illegal immigration can have on the USA.
- Paragraph 2: Students should find or give reasons against the assertion.

**N.B**: Each paragraph should have a topic sentence.

❖ Conclusion. (5 pts)

## > Mechanics of writing

Give marks for the following:

- Use of correct punctuation.
- Paragraphs should be visible: Topic sentences and examples to illustrate them.
- Capitalization.
- Discourse markers: coherence of sentences within paragraphs and of all the paragraphs.

## > Coherence and language.

The writing should make sense as a whole.

- Use of formal language. (Contracted forms not allowed).
- Use of appropriate vocabulary, grammar and connectors.

## TASK B: ARTICLE WRITING. (40 pts)

## **General expectations**

As an article writing, candidates are normally expected to respect the layout (structure) of article writing.

## \*Title (10 pts)

It should be related to the topic; short; underlined or set in a frame; written in block letters or the first letter of each word in capital or block letters, attractive, etc.)

#### Marking scheme.

The piece of writing should contain the following:

- 1) **Introduction** in which the candidate states his / her viewpoints. (5 pts)
- 2) **Body** (or <u>Development</u>) in two or three paragraphs to explain his (her) opinion by providing relevant arguments to explain the thesis. (15 pts)
- 3) <u>Conclusion</u> (sum up the points of view and make suggestions to stop illegal immigration). (5 pts)
  - 4) Signature (5 pts)
    - **Mechanics of writing** (use of punctuation, paragraphing, topic sentences, capitalization, etc)
    - Coherence and cohesion
    - **Language** (vocabulary, grammar)
    - **N. B:** Candidates should not use contraction forms)
